Shift-right-click and choose "Install for all users".

Inkscape: Move text along a path

Using the XML Editor

1. In Inkscape, open the XML Editor `Ctrl+Shift+X`.
2. In the XML Editor, find the `<svg:text>`. (You can click the text in Inkscape to jump to it in the XML Editor.)
3. Select the `<svg:textPath>` child of the `<svg:text>`.
4. On the right side of the XML Editor in the box next to the *Set* button, enter `startOffset`. Below it, enter the value you want to move along the path.
5. Click *Set*.

Davinci Resolve

Applying Transitions to all clips

- Left-click on the desired transition and set it as default.
- Select the clips you want it applied to.
- Press ctrl-T
- To apply audio fade, use shift-T
